- **ADVANCE SHIPMENT MUST ARRIVE BETWEEN: May 3 – 17, 2010**
- **DIRECT SHIPMENT - arrival at the day of official move-in date May 24, 2010**

- All shipments must be accompanied with a bill of lading indicating the number of pieces, weight and description of contents.
- For International Shipments (e.g. U.S.A. to Canada), the International Courier Waybill must specify "BILL ALL CHARGES TO SHIPPER". This includes DUTIES/TAXES/ CUSTOMS. If this is not indicated, GES CANADA/Place Bonaventure Loading Dock will not accept the shipment, which will then be delayed at customs.
- A COMMERCIAL INVOICE must be completed for all International Shipments. All charges, including Canadian duty and taxes are to be billed to the shipper.
- Once shipped, copies of the bill of lading must be immediately faxed to GES CANADA along with the name of your on-site representative in order to plan for your shipments.
